Club Events and Nominated Open Events

The table below lists the NSW club events and nominated open events for 2025. It shows the various club competitions for which each event counts.

All club events will be Entry-on-the-line, so advance entries will not be required. No advance start sheets will be issued. Entry fees for NSW members for the above events will be $\underline{\textbf{£5.00}}$ per rider, (£3 of which is CTT levy). For Non NSW members the entry fee will be £6 per rider.

Nominated open events (O), used as club events, will need to be entered on line via the CTT website.

Evening 10 mile Series (Wednesdays, HQ at Prees Cricket and Sports Club)

- The evening 10 series will be on two courses, the Prees course (D32/10)*, and a course based on the Hawkstone circuit (D310/2)*. *Course details below.
- HQ for all evening events (except the Hillclimb) will be at Prees Cricket and Sports Club in Prees Village.
- Start time is 19:00 or 19:30 (details in events listing) on top of the Prees bypass for both courses. Allow at least 10 mins to ride to the start.
- Points awarded 10 1, best 6 scores to count.
- Entry and sign on at HQ from 18:00. Sign on will close at 18:30.
- Entry fee for NSW members will be **£5.00** (Non NSW members £6.00)
